

Attention All Nurses

If you have a few hours to spare a week and currently undertake insurance medicals or would like to, please complete the nurse registration form and return to us.

We require nurses from all over the UK, Eire, Channel Islands to undertake paramedical screening for insurance purposes on our behalf.

Medicals to take place at mutually convenient times normally at the clients' home and sometimes at the place of work. All Medical reports are returned in pre-paid envelopes to the Chief Medical Officer of Principle Medical Services.

Medical Content

The medical normally takes about 20-30 minutes and consists of:

- Taking a personal and family history
- Height and weight
- Blood pressure check
- Peak flow reading
- Testing a urine sample for protein etc

Optionally requested:

- Taking a sample of blood (if you have appropriate experience)
- Taking of an Oral Fluid Sample (saliva swab) to test for HIV and/or Cotinine (smoking habits)
- 3 Blood pressure readings
- Occasional supplementary questionnaires

We also undertake other assessments on behalf of our clients which require a speciality in Occupational Health and Case Management.
